

Yurlu Nullagine Caravan Parks and Cape Keraudren

Terms and Conditions

General Acceptance: You agree to the Terms and Conditions of Stay (this document) by reservation or by entering the Park. Third-Party Terms and Conditions will not apply to any guest or staff member in Yurlu/Nullagine Caravan Park or Cape Keraudren. In the event that such terms are contradicted by third-party terms or conditions, the Guest agrees Yurlu/Nullagine Caravan Park or Cape Keraudren Terms and Conditions of Stay will apply as overarching and governing.

Bookings, Fees & Charges: Full payment is required at time of booking. All bookings are to be made in the name of the Guest(s) staying on site.

The tariff quoted is based on the number and type of guests for the specified time and duration. Any changes to these details may affect the tariff. Prices are current at time of booking and are inclusive of GST. All rates quoted are in Australian Dollars (\$AUD)

Sites:

Check in is 2pm for all Sites

Check out is 11am

Early check in and late check out are subject to availability and can be requested with the Caravan Park Officer.

To maintain Grass for all to enjoy the grass sites max stay 3 nights.

Sites may only be booked in 14-day allotments, if you choose to stay longer than 14 days you must make a new booking with a new site allocation. Every 28 days you must vacate the park for minimum of 48 hours.

One Vehicle permitted at each site, sharing power with any other then the Individual booked is strictly prohibited. No extension cords from other sites/Caravans/Vehicles are permitted to be used for sharing of power. Fees will apply and/or guests booking may be terminated at the discretion of the Caravan Officer.

Guests are only allowed to stay in their allocated site. Sleeping in public places such as the Recreation room is not permitted. All customers have the right to be able to use these shared areas for their intended purpose. Please be aware that failure to abide by these conditions will result in refusal of future bookings and possible cancellation of existing bookings with immediate effect.

Maximum of 6 persons per site

Waste/Sullage/Dump Point

Please wrap and contain waste, use bins through the park and where available please recycle.

Sullage is to be collected and disposed of to approved sullage points only.

Please use dump points provided to dispose of human waste.

Storage of Vans: In extenuating circumstance unoccupied vans may be accepted to remain onsite at the tariff of the site occupied and subject to booking guidelines.

Method of Payment: The Shire accepts the following methods of payment for reservations and security bonds:

- EFTPOS
- Credit Card (Mastercard and Visa accepted only)
- Cash

Arrival / Departure: You are free to arrive from 2pm. All accommodation and sites are to be vacated by 10am on day of departure. If you would like to make alternate arrangements, please ensure you see our team at reception prior to arrival or scheduled departure time.

Cancellations: Reservation cancelled less than 3 days prior to the scheduled arrival date will incur a charge the equivalent to one night's stay per booking.

Children: Please be aware that any guest under 18 years of age must be accompanied by an adult during their stay. We do not accept booking by minors.

All children within the park are the responsibility of their parent or guardian. Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult when using the amenities and other park facilities.

Smoking: No smoking inside or outside any of the park facilities including camp kitchen, pool area, ablutions, reception, laundry and park owned on site accommodation.

Please only smoke in open areas and away from other guests.

Noise: Please be respectful of others and their enjoyment within the park by restricting noise from music, televisions, and social gatherings between 8pm and 6am.

Generators allowed during daylight hours and only at the discretion of the Caravan Park Officer

Visitors: If there is an additional person (or persons) to the number of persons disclosed as staying on site, an additional fee may be payable. If you have a visitor who does not leave the Park by 9.00 pm, The Shire of East Pilbara has the right to treat the visitor as an additional person which may incur an additional fee.

Pet Policy: Dogs are permitted in the Caravan Park/Campground but must not bark excessively, cause a disturbance and or be left unattended. Dogs must always remain on a lead. Owners are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs.

Dogs are not allowed inside the recreation/BBQ areas, showers, and laundry with the exception of guide and assistance dogs as defined under s. 8 of the Dog Act (1976). Washing of animal bedding in the laundry is strictly prohibited.

Dog owners must agree that the park managers reserve the right to remove any guest whose dog is deemed disruptive, noisy or aggressive or the subject to any complaints from other guests.

No other animals are permitted on the grounds.

Fires: Open fires are strictly prohibited anywhere in the Yurlu and Nullagine caravan parks.

Cape Keraudren campfires are permitted in designated camping areas except for total fire ban days.

Liability: Anyone defacing or causing damage to any buildings, equipment, or property of the park faces immediate eviction and prosecution.

The person who made the booking will be responsible for and charged for any damage/loss caused by themselves or their party to the site or to any park facility or other guests' property. Your personal belongings, vehicles, vans, and their accessories and contents are left at your own risk.

The Shire nor its staff will not be liable for the loss, theft, or damage of any property nor for any injury, accident, or mishap to any person in the park.

Customers must ensure that their property is secured and fully insured for any unforeseen eventuality.

Unauthorised Activities: Antisocial behaviour, illegal drug use, excessive use of alcohol, undue mess around the site, excessive noise, acts of violence, and smoking in accommodation are strictly prohibited. Failure to comply with any of the above rules, including any damage caused to the property, may result in eviction.

Emergency: In case of fire, police or ambulance emergencies, please dial 000.

Yurlu and Nullagine Caravan Park Assistance by park management will be available between 8am and 6.30pm, a mobile number is posted at reception entry.

Cape Keraudren Rangers number is available onsite.
