Basket Weaving

Bookings not required, informal creative space. Join Martumili artists in the gallery for a basket weaving circle. Weaving is a skill that has been practiced by Martu for thousands of years, making items such as yakapiri (bark sandals) and manguri (head pads for balancing carved carrying dishes). Now we see brightly coloured coiled baskets, made with wool puntayarra and minarri grass. Come and sit down with the artists, grab some grass and some wool and see what you can create!

Kirrikin's 2024 collection is called EVOKE, and features the artwork of Buffie Punch - telling the story of her Country. Look out for beautiful colours that evoke the south west of our beautiful state
