WA's Safe Transition Plan:

Border controls eased with conditions

Domestic arrivals



Double dose vaccinated arrivals only (those eligible for a vaccine), and G2G Pass required

Interstate travellers arriving to WA



Negative PCR test within 72 hours before departure



If your trip into WA is 6 days or more, undertake a PCR test within 48 hours of arrival



If your trip into WA is 5 days or less, no PCR test is required on arrival

WA travellers returning to WA



If your trip away is 5 days or less only a PCR test is required within 48 hours of arrival back into WA



If your trip away is 6 days or more, a negative PCR test within 72 hours before departure and a test within 48 hours of arrival is also required

International arrivals



No quarantine for double dose vaccinated arrivals



Negative PCR test within 72 hours before departure



Test within 48 hours of arrival to WA and on Day 6



No caps on the number of vaccinated arrivals



14 days quarantine in a designated facility for unvaccinated people

International arrangements are subject to **Commonwealth Biosecurity settings**

Public health and social measures



Masks to be worn for some high risk indoor settings

- public transport, taxis and rideshare
- visitors to hospitals, residential aged and disability care facilities, and custodial corrections facilities
- airports and on flights



Contact registration (SafeWA) at all public venues, taxis and rideshare services



Revised COVID Safety Plans, Event Plans and Checklist



Proof of vaccination required

- large events (1000+)
- nightclubs
- Crown complex Optus Stadium
- RAC Arena
- HBF Stadium Main Arena
- HBF Park



Restricted entry to remote Aboriginal communities, where necessary

Additional requirements for regions below an 80% double dose vaccination rate



Additional proof of vaccination requirements

- pubs, bars, bottle shops, dine-in restaurants and cafes
- fitness centres and gyms
- indoor entertainment venues
- travel into the region by air travel



Masks must be worn in indoor public venues without a proof of vaccination entry requirement

Public health and social measures could increase based on up-to-date health advice



Get vaccinated, including your third dose when eligible.



Get your proof of vaccination



Keep checking in
