What you need to know about the Local Planning Scheme Review

The Shire's Local Planning Strategy identifies key actions to be implemented at a Shire wide and neighbourhood level. It contains recommendations which inform the review of the Local Planning Scheme, such as considerations to property zoning, density and land use.

A Local Planning Scheme sets out development controls, including the zoning of land, permissible land uses, the scale of development and other requirements that apply to development in the Shire. The review will ensure the Shire has an up-to-date planning framework to support good planning outcomes into the future. The Shire is now seeking feedback to inform the draft Scheme Review, allowing its planning approach to remain contemporary in response to changing community priorities.

The Shire will use your feedback to develop a draft Local Planning Scheme, which will be available for further public comment in 2025.

We will then respond to your comments and improve the Scheme further. Once improved, it will be submitted to Council and the Western Australian Planning Commission for consideration and approval.
