Please Note:

- Roads will be slippery and unsuitable for travel on after significant rainfall.
- The towing of trailers or caravans on unsealed roads over the Wet Season is not recommended.
- Be aware of stock on or near the road.
- Approach and drive slowly through road works and past maintenance graders to avoid vehicle damage.
