REPORT PURPOSE

For Council to endorse the Sponsorship funding for inclusion in the 2023/24 budget.

BACKGROUND

At its meeting held 25 November 2022, Council adopted the revised Grants and Sponsorship Policy (**Appendix 1**) and adopted the new Grants and Sponsorship Guidelines at the Ordinary Council Meeting held on 24 February 2023 (**Appendix 2**). This encompasses Sponsorships and the ongoing grants provided throughout the year.

As per the Guidelines, organisations are required to submit a sponsorship application two months prior to their event, must be \$5,000 or more and requests for assistance must be approved by Council.

Providing sponsorship to local community groups and organisations aligns to the Shire's Community vision to build on our strengths to grow and create opportunities for all and to be proud, connected and resourced. The Sponsorship recommendation is based on the impacts and outcomes these proposed activities will deliver for the community whilst aligning to the Shire's Community Vision and Strategic Community Plan whilst providing economic benefits to the Shire of East Pilbara.

The table found in Appendix 3 details the requests received for Council's consideration.

COMMENTS/OPTIONS/DISCUSSIONS

The Shire received three (3) applications for Sponsorships to be considered for inclusion in the 2023/24 budget. However the Administration has identified that one proponent (Marble Bar Race Club) application from the Community Grants Round was better suited under the Sponsorship program. The rationale for assessment under the Sponsorship Program was due to the proposed event would have direct financial impact on the Shire of East Pilbara and capacity to attract large numbers of participants. Whereby Community Grants provide applicants with funding to deliver initiatives that foster collaboration and target identify gap/targeted cohorts. Therefore, the total number of applications for consideration under Sponsorship was increased from three (3) to four (4) applications.

However, prior to the June 30 Council meeting, the Marble Bar Race Club (proponent) made a further request for funding to Council for the same funding event. Without knowing the result of their first application, the proponents request was assessed under the Grants and Sponsorship Policy and considering that the initial application was deemed and assessed under the Sponsorship Program selection criteria, the proponent was subsequently asked to re-submit a revised application. Under the Sponsorship program criteria, sponsorship for amounts over \$5000 are available all year round. The appropriate assessment process was then convened and completed through an Assessment Panel and the result of the Marble Bar Race Club revised application was endorsed.

Each applicant is required to complete and submit a detailed acquittal report to the Shire within 30 days of completion of their activity. More information on individual applications and rationale for recommendation can be found in Appendix 3.

For the 2023/24 financial year, and as per the table in below, the Administration is recommending the following three (3) applications be considered for Sponsorship support, totaling \$39,955.
