REPORT PURPOSE

In response to a Notice of Motion put forward by Cr Langtree Coppin requesting that the Chief Executive Officer's delegated authority to approve amounts of expenditure up to \$499,999 be revoked and a new amount be discussed and approved.

BACKGROUND

Notice of Motion from Councillor Langtree Coppin for consideration at the 16 December 2022 Ordinary Council Meeting:

Motion:

That Council revokes the CEO's current final delegation of \$499,999 and authorises a new delegation amount of \$_____ to be discussed and determined by Council on 16 December 2022.

OFFICER RESPONSE

Council authorised the current Delegations and Authorisations Register at its ordinary meeting on 22 July 2022:

That Council adopts the reviewed Shire of East Pilbara Register of Delegations and Authorisations as appendix 1 to the report, amending the value in Delegations 1.2.18 (1) & (9) to \$499,999 (ex GST).

The rationale behind the recommendation to increase the Chief Executive Officer's financial delegation was to improve the efficiency of delivery of infrastructure and services by reducing the time required for the calling of, acceptance or rejection of tenders that would otherwise require Council approval.

In that time, the Chief Executive Officer has exercised the power to approve tenders within the authorised delegation on five (5) occasions. Council has authorised tenders

on eight (8) occasions, including one (1) that was within the Chief Executive Officer's delegation. Details of those tenders are included as **Appendix 1** to this report. Councillors may consider supporting an amendment to Councillor Coppin's motion to impose a further condition on the exercise of the delegation by the Chief Executive Officer, which would require the referral of all plant purchases over the value of \$250,000 (ex GST) to Council for approval:

That Council amends the Chief Executive Officer's existing financial delegation to authorise purchases of up to \$499,999 (ex GST), to include the following conditions:

- (1) all purchases of any plant greater than or equal to \$250,000 (ex GST) be referred to Council's Plant Committee for consultation; and
- (2) the recommendation of the Plant Committee be referred to Council for decision.

It is noted that internal procedures have been set to ensure that large plant purchases will be referred to the Plant Committee. If supported by Council, the inclusion of the conditions above would provide Council with the ultimate decision making authority. Should Council impose a reduced financial authority for the Chief Executive Officer, all purchases above that value must be referred to Council for determination.

STATUTORY IMPLICATIONS/REQUIREMENTS

The motion is consistent with section 5.46(2) of the *Local Government Act 1995*, and requires an Absolute Majority.

It is noted that regulation 10(1)(b) of the *Local Government (Administration)* Regulations 1996 ("the Regulations") requires the notice of a motion of revocation or which proposes to substantially change a previous decision of Council more than three (3) months after it has been determined, to be given by at least one-third of the offices of the Council – that is by a minimum of four (4) councillors. This notice of this motion has been provided by only one (1) councillor. As no dollar value has been provided by the proposed motion, it is recommended that consideration of Cr Coppin's motion be allowed unless the value nominated in the motion were to substantially change Council's decision of 22 July 2022, in which case, consideration of the motion must lapse.

It is considered that in the event the conditions proposed above were to be placed on the purchase of items of plant, the change to that previous decision would not be considered 'substantial' for the purposes of the regulation, and that the exception provided by Regulations would apply, that is:

(3) This regulation does not apply to the change of a decision unless the effect of the change would be that the decision would be revoked or would become substantially different.
