Health Local Laws

The Shire of East Pilbara's Health Local Law 2011, allows for person to keep no more than two cats over the age of three months at any premises within the shire. A third cat may be applied for in writing.

Cat Microchipping

All cats over the age of six months must have a microchip implanted. The microchip contains a unique identification code that when scanned by a Ranger, will lead to identifying your cats particulars and its owners contact details being available.

In some instances, lost animals have been reunited with their long lost owners after being located in another town or different state.

Cat Sterilisation

All cats over the age of six months must be sterilised. Our new cat laws are about encouraging responsible pet ownership and reducing the number of unwanted cats in the community and the number that are euthanised each year.

When registering your cat for the first time, you will be required to show proof that your cat has been sterilised. Evidence of your cats sterilisation can be in the form of:

- Sterilisation Certificate issued by your Vet or;
- Statutory Declaration.

Cat owner responsibilities

- 1. Cats six months & over must be micro chipped, sterilised & registered.
- 2. The Shire must be informed immediately in writing or by email of any change in ownership, the death of the cat or change of address.
- 3. Proof of sterilisation is required.
- 4. Proof of Microchipping required for all new cat registrations.
- 5. Make sure your cat wears a collar with the registration tag and a bell.
- 6. Don t allow your cat to roam. This will reduce the risk of cats injuring birds and reptiles.
- 7. Vaccinate your cats
