Putting your bins out for collection



Place bins out by 6am on your collection day



Maximum weight of each bin is 50kg



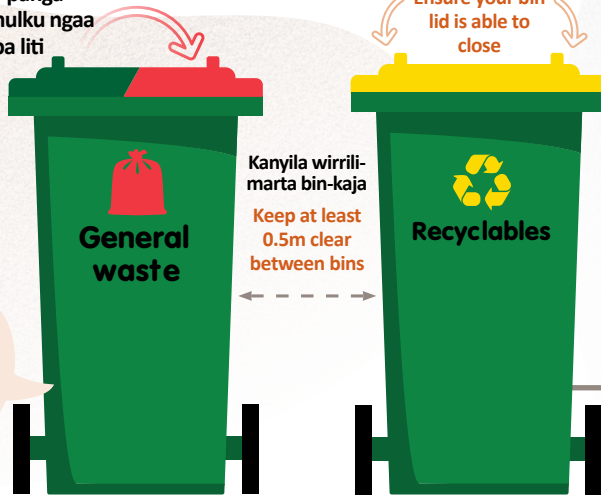
Retrieve your bin from kerbside by 6pm after collection.

The Shire is phasing in **red bin lids** for general waste to improve consistency with the rest of WA.

Keep at least 1m clear of cars, mailboxes and fences etc

Do not park in front of bins and keep laneways clear

Important Information

Take these Items to the Recycling Station at Newman Waste Management Facility. These dangerous items do not belong in any bin.

- **Paint / Paint-pa**
- **Aerosol cans / Arosol can-kaja**

Not all items can go in your kerbside bins

Take household hazardous items to the Newman Waste Management Facility for safe disposal and recycling. We all use hazardous chemicals and materials in our homes every day – batteries, paint, household chemicals, aerosol cans and gas canisters. At the end of their useful lives, we need to take special care to dispose of them properly. They are often flammable, toxic, explosive or corrosive and cannot be disposed of in household bins.

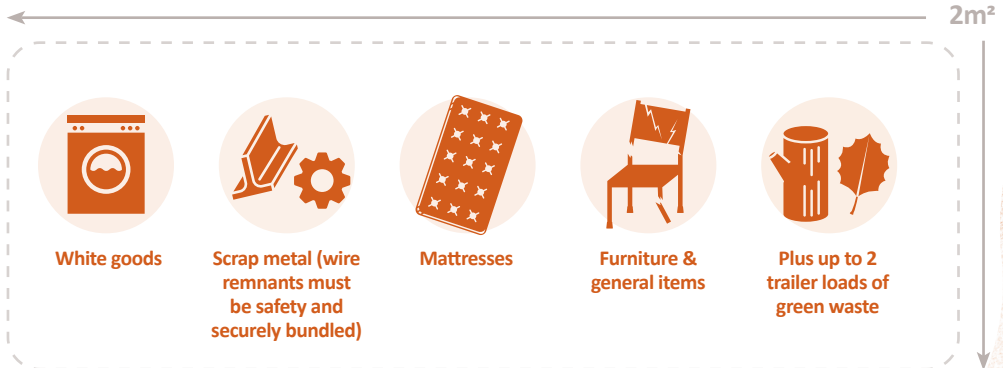
Recycling at Newman's Library, the Shires Administration Office or at the East Pilbara's Refund Point



Annual Bulk Waste Verge Collection

In the first and second week of November

We collect up to two cubic metres of waste per household, including:



It's easy to sort waste into 5 separate piles to help us recycle

Green waste can be placed on the verge up to 2 weeks prior to the collection start date.

Please Do

- ✓ Place bulk waste neatly on your verge by 7am on the advertised collection week.
- ✓ Allow 7 working days for collection.
- ✓ Keep checking your pile as it is your responsibility to ensure waste remains tidy until collected.
- ✓ Secure waste on your property if strong winds are forecast, or a severe weather warning is issued.

Please Don't

- ✗ Place your bulk waste on any other verge as it WILL NOT be collected from vacant land or public reserves.
- ✗ Obstruct the footpath or the line of sight for pedestrians, cyclists and cars.
- ✗ Exceed the allowed volume of waste.
- ✗ Place items near services, reticulation, walls or other structures.

What won't be collected:

- ✗ More than two trailer loads of green waste
- ✗ Unsorted items
- ✗ Bricks, rubble, concrete or cement
- ✗ Band, soil or lawn sods
- ✗ Food waste
- ✗ Glass or mirrors
- ✗ Gas bottles or cylinders
- ✗ Car bodies/parts, tyres/batteries
- ✗ Asbestos or other fibrous cement
- ✗ Hazardous Waste or Liquids (paint, oil, garden chemicals, pesticides, oil-filled radiators/heaters etc.)
- ✗ Small items that need to be boxed or bagged for collection - e.g., clothing, books, 'knickknacks'.

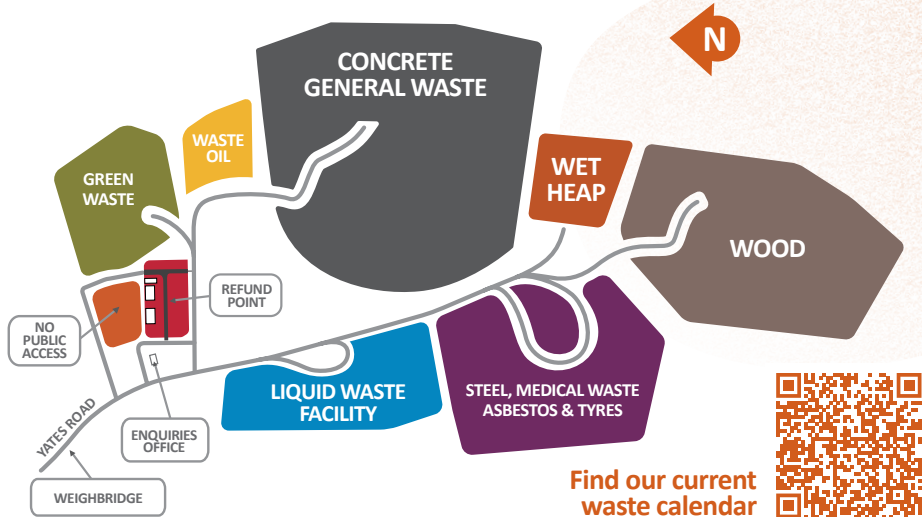

Free disposal and recycling for residents

Separate your load



Recycling

Glass bottles, plastic bottles/containers, steel/aluminium cans, clean paper and cardboard.



Walku waste-pa Problem waste

Gas bottles, paint, fluro globes and tubes, batteries, oils and smoke detectors, e-waste and household chemicals.



Metal waste-pa Metal waste

Scrap metal, white goods, fencing, sheet metal, car parts, bikes and lawnmowers.



Garden waste-pa Green waste

Grass clippings, tree branches, stumps and untreated timber.



Kujupa waste-kaja Mixed waste

Treated timber, broken items that cannot be reused, recycled or composted.



Jutula-ngka trailer or tray kalikikulu nyuntuku rapigi punkaljaku

Cover your trailer or tray with a tarp to avoid your rubbish becoming litter

Mulch is available free for residents when self-loaded.

Cash in your containers!

To get a 10c refund, take your eligible drink containers to the Shire of East Pilbara's Containers for Change Refund Point at the Newman Waste Management Facility, Yates Road Newman.

Palya containers

Eligible containers:

- ✓ Glass-pa, plastic (HDPE/PET), aluminium-steel-pakamu paper-jamu katin-kaja
- ✓ Glass, plastic (HDPE/ PET), aluminium, steel and paper-based cartons
- ✓ Ngapijanu 150 mls ngapikarti 3L
From 150 mls to 3 litres
- ✓ Purchased WA-ngka
- ✓ Purchased in WA
- ✓ Nyakyn refund marka-ka
Display the refund mark

Walyka containers

Ineligible containers:

- ✗ Plain milk, flavoured milks 1L and above
- ✗ Pure juice drinks 1L and above
- ✗ Wine bottle-pa
- ✗ Wine bottles
- ✗ Spirit bottle-kaja
- ✗ Spirit bottles
- ✗ Cordial-kaja
- ✗ Cordials



- ✓ Remove container lids prior to depositing your containers
- ✓ Container lids are recycled separately at the refund point
- ✓ Cash refunds are limited to \$20 per customer, refunds above are only paid via Scheme ID

Litter kamu illegal dumping-pa

Litter and Illegal Dumping

Juntumalku illegal dumping-pa kamu rapiji Report illegal dumping and littering

1. Take note of the location

Where the dumped material or litter is located, e.g. street name or landmark.

2. Take note of what you saw

Description of the dumped material or litter, e.g. size, quantity, material type, any items you can identify. You can email a image if you have taken a photo.

3. Report it

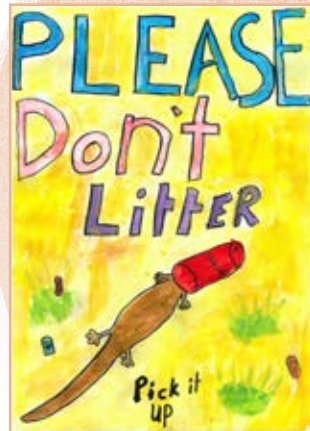
Littering is an offence under the Litter Act 1979 and carries a fine of up to \$5,000 for individuals and \$10,000 for corporations.

Tips to help keep our Shire beautiful

- Utilising the Newman Waste Management Facility, which is FREE for residents
- Ensuring goods carried on trailers, utes and trucks are covered and properly secured
- Reporting abandoned vehicles, littering and illegal dumping

Sometimes it takes a community - feed the animals!

Even if you do not have the time or space to compost at home, you can give your food waste a second chance by donating food scraps to the Newman Lions Club Animal Park to feed the animals, including, kangaroos, sheep, goats, chickens, ducks and a pig! Please no meat, citrus or onions.



Only flush-munku ngapi marnkurrpa P's

Only flush the Three P's

Never flush anything other than the **three P's – pee, poo and toilet paper** down the toilet. Anything other than toilet paper should go in the bin.

Flushing anything other than the three P's down the toilets costs ratepayers and the Shire's ability to water our greenspaces and ovals with quality treated water.

Please do

- ✓ Only flush the 3 P's – pee, poo and paper
- ✓ Keep a bin in your bathroom to dispose of rubbish
- ✓ Dispose of any cleaning cloths and fabrics in your general waste bin
- ✓ Use strainers in sink holes and empty scraps into general waste bin or compost
- ✓ Pour any used oil, fatty liquids or old milk into a container and place it in the general waste bin.
- ✓ Dispose of used motor oil, paint or chemicals at the Newman Waste Management Facility

Please don't:

- ✗ Flush wet wipes, cleaning clothes or other rubbish down the toilet
- ✗ Pour fats, oils and grease down the sink or drain
- ✗ Our chemicals, oils, paints, solvents and pesticides down the sink or drain



Caring for our environment!

Newman's treated waste water is used to water our parks and ovals and greenspaces.

We don't need to use drinking water to irrigate. Water from our treatment plant can do the job safely and reduces the stress on our drinking water sources!
