FENCING AMENDMENT LOCAL LAW 2026

Under the powers conferred by the *Local Government Act 1995*, and all other powers enabling it, the Council of the Shire of East Pilbara resolved on 12 December 2025 to make the following local law.

1.Citation

This local law is cited as the *Shire of East Pilbara Fencing Amendment Local Law 2026*.

2.Commencement

This local law comes into operation 14 days after its publication in the *Government Gazette*.

3.Principal Local Law

This local law amends the *Shire of East Pilbara Fencing Local Law 2011* as published in the *Government Gazette* on 26 March 2012.

4.Clause 2.8 amended

In clause 2.8—

- a) After (2)(c), insert—
 - (3) Notwithstanding the provisions of clause 2.10(3) and (4), the local government may approve the erection or repair of a barbed wire fence or fence of other materials with spiked or jagged projections on an Industrial Lot where the owner of that Lot has submitted an application for approval for that purpose.
 - (4) In determining whether to grant its approval under subclause (3), the local government may consider whether varying the requirements of clause 2.10(3) or (4) would have an adverse effect on –
 - (a) the safe or convenient use of any land;
 - (b) the safety or convenience of any person; or
 - (c) the visual amenity of the locality.
